### Introduction

At Oaklands Park, Religious Education will be grounded in the context of Christianity with reference to other faiths and beliefs at appropriate times of the year.

### Aims

- To encourage pupils to value themselves, others and to create opportunities for respecting beliefs and viewpoints
- To encourage pupils to understand the teaching of world religions with particular focus on Christianity

### RE at Oaklands Park

- The RE curriculum will be broad, balanced and relevant. With all elements differentiated and designed to develop attitudes, knowledge and skills
- We will acknowledge the locally agreed Devon syllabus, in our planning

### Methodology

RE can be divided into two strands, implicit and explicit.

Implicit: self-awareness, relationships with others, wonder and respect of the natural world, with clear links to PHSE and Environmental Education

Explicit: specific stories, festivals and symbols

### Recording, Reporting and Assessing pupil's and student's work.

- There is no requirement to formally assess attainment and progress in RE
